Course Description

OT-842* Environmental Determinants of Occupation

This course will focus on the creation of healthy environments that enable client-centred occupations. Students will examine factors within the physical, social, cultural and institutional environments that affect occupation and how environmental modifications can lead to changes in occupation. They will gain experience with the knowledge and skills critical to effecting environmental change.

TA Qualifications

Duties: Organization and supervision of technology lab; marking student oral presentations; marking of written assignments related to the environmental determinants of occupation; and marking of final exams.

Competencies: organizational skills, comprehensive understanding of rehab/disability, ability to provide verbal and written feedback. The incumbent should feel competent to grade assignments or exams related to ergonomics, home modifications to enable occupational performance, accessibility in the community and return to work / occupational rehab. Knowledge of resources, policy and legislation related to the environment is an asset (e.g. AODA, WSIB, Occupational Health and Safety Act, Building Code, The Education Act, CMHC, etc.)
