Course Description

OT-871* Advanced Clinical Reasoning

Weight = 4 credit units

This course provides opportunities for students to develop advanced clinical reasoning skills applicable to all areas of occupational therapy practice. Based on the occupational therapy process, students will develop skills of critical thinking and inquiry.

TA Qualifications

Two TAs: One TA with an OT background for 27 hours and one TA with a non-OT background for 30 hours. Some virtual hours will be considered.

OT background:

Duties:

1. Facilitation of volunteer/SP interactions for 4 weeks of classes (3hrs each designated class)
2. Co-lecturing/class facilitation – for 2 weeks of class
3. Marking of final examination

Non OT background

Duties:

1. Marking essay format assignment following detailed marking guide rubric
2. Assist with coordination of the Standardized patient interviews (trouble shooting with an AV issues, redoing the interviews in the CEC etc.)
