

## **OT 875 TA Requirement (Total of 55 hours)**

### **One Position**

OT/PT - 55 hours (OT preferred)

### **Course Description**

#### **OT 875           Advanced Professional Practice**

This course is designed to provide students with opportunities to acquire an advanced understanding of the roles, rights and responsibilities incumbent with becoming an Occupational Therapist. Particular attention will be given to the legal and ethical parameters of practice, professional contributions and responsibilities within complex and changing environments and career development as advanced healthcare professionals. Course content is designed to be responsive to the shifting practice environment and offer students an opportunity to synthesize learning from other courses within the curriculum.

### **Qualifications of TA**

**Duties:** provide assistance with grading student presentations; in-class assistance with moderating group activities and assistance with exam proctoring for students requiring accommodation; assistance with grading students' written assignments, including professional portfolios.

**Competencies:** knowledge of the CAOT "Profile of Occupational Therapy Practice in Canada"; OT preferred but would also consider PT; requires rehabilitation background or an individual with a strong professional background.
