Course Description

This course builds on attitudes, knowledge and skills developed in Cognitive-Neurological Dimensions of Occupation I. Students will practice evaluations, and evidence-informed interventions relevant to complex cognitive-neurological issues within a range of neurological impairments in adults. Weekly labs will provide the opportunity for further skill development

TA Competencies

Knowledge of adult neurological conditions and their effects on occupation.

TA Duties

Small group tutoring or lab preparation/supervision of clinical cases/practice and marking exams. The time will be spent: 1) Guiding students in the labs to complete tasks such as determining OT goals, assessment and interventions for presented case scenarios. 2) Marking exams.
