

## OT OSCE Support - TA Requirements (Total of 42 hours)

November 20 – December 8, 2017 and May 22 – June 9, 2018

Two Positions – one at 14 hours, one at 28 hours (either or both may be OT or non-OT)

### Job Description

This position will provide support to the instructors of **OT 881- Physical Determinants of Occupation I** and **OT 883 – Cognitive-Neurological Determinants of Occupation I** in the preparation for and delivery of the Objective Structured Clinical Exams (OSCEs) associated with those courses. The incumbents will assist with various aspects of the OSCE exams, as detailed below. Time requirements will be flexible before each OSCE, but onsite presence will be required on the OSCE dates:
