Course Description

### **OT/PT 897            Critical Enquiry Foundations**

Course Description: This course prepares students for the completion of the 898 critical enquiry project by examining world views, research designs, criteria for study quality, and evidence-based practice. Students develop skills to pose clinical questions, systematically search the literature, appraise scientific articles, and use research to inform rehabilitation practice.
