- Provide assessment of children referred through Intake on the basis of developmental delays, specifically motor related delays
- Develop and implement treatment plans based on initial and ongoing assessments. Review and modify programming as needed
- Maintain documentation as per college guidelines and FIREFLY policies and procedures
- Provide information to help facilitate understanding and access to the assistive devices program and other funding initiatives for special equipment
- Work collaboratively with community based service providers and agencies to meet identified needs and enhance delivery of care
- Extensive travel required
