- Registration with the College of Occupational Therapists of Ontario
- Proven ability to develop effective relationships with clients and members of an interdisciplinary client care team
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Previous experience working with children
- Ability to be creative and flexible with service provision, both in-person and virtually
- Hold a valid Ontario Driver's Licence and have access to a personal vehicle

The successful candidate will be required to submit a Police Vulnerable Sector Check. Knowledge of and experience working with Indigenous peoples and communities is considered an asset. Bilingualism English/French is considered an asset.
