Oscar's Place is the only privately funded centre for children in Collingwood, Ontario and proudly serves both Simcoe and Grey Counties. We provide a multidisciplinary approach to pediatric rehabilitation, offering physiotherapy, speech-language pathology, occupational therapy, and mental health services catered to the needs of children and their parents.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Occupational Therapist works to improve participation and quality of life through a child's ability to perform role-appropriate, day-to-day tasks necessary for self-care (such as feeding, dressing, toileting); productivity (such as school, work); and leisure and play within their environment. This process involves assessment, identification of strengths and needs, goal-setting, treatment planning, and implementation of treatment in a direct, indirect or consultative manner, as indicated, then discharge. This position is part-time, quickly growing into a full-time position.

QUALIFICATIONS & SKILLS:

- Registration and membership in good standing with the College of Occupational Therapists of Ontario
- Post-secondary degree in occupational therapy
- Sound understanding of occupational therapy amongst children and youth (ages 0-18)
- Strong interest or experience in: school-based rehabilitation, autism spectrum disorders, active rehabilitation for children 0-18yrs of age with various neurological, developmental and/or physical challenges
- Ability to assess, treat, consult and educate children and youth with physical and/or developmental delays or challenges
- Effectively educate children/youth, families and other care providers related to their specific needs, utilizing a variety of strategies and through a variety of mediums (group, individual, lectures, online, etc.)
