The Occupational Therapist works within a inter-professional team setting to provide therapy services to patients in medically complex and slow-paced rehabilitation programs for adult and geriatric populations. They perform assessments and develops and implements individualized therapeutic programs to enhance and maximize patients' functional abilities. He/she participates in discharge planning to help ensure that patients graduate to the most appropriate living option, whether that be independent living, assisted living, or institutional care.

Additional responsibilities include:

- recommending adaptive equipment, exercise regimes and other activities to enhance independence with respect to activities of daily living, mobility and transfers
- modifying adaptive equipment based on patient needs
- providing education to patients and families and advising on post-discharge services

- Current registration with the College of Occupational Therapists of Ontario
- ADP Authorizer certification and experience in geriatric rehab would be considered assets
- Experience with seating and mobility
