COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course emphasizes the neuro-physiological organization of motor behaviour, sensorymotor integration, and the dynamic nature of the central nervous system. The course will provide a foundation for evaluating occupational performance with a focus on evaluation and intervention approaches for cognitive-perceptual and motor control problems for adults at three levels: impairment, strategy and function. Attention will be given to secondary motor performance problems.

DUTIES:

Small group tutoring or lab preparation/supervision of clinical cases/practice and marking exams. The time will be spent: 1) Guiding students in the labs to complete tasks such as determining OT goals, assessment and interventions for presented case scenarios. 2) Marking exams. Any in-person sessions will be conducted in compliance with all Public Health safety guidelines.
