COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course builds on attitudes, knowledge and skills developed in Cognitive-Neurological Dimensions of Occupation I. Students will practice evaluations, and evidence-informed interventions relevant to complex cognitive-neurological issues within a range of neurological impairments in adults. Labs will provide the opportunity for further skill development.

DUTIES:

Small group tutoring or lab preparation/supervision of clinical cases/practice and marking exams. The time will be spent:

- 1) Guiding students in the labs to complete tasks such as determining OT goals, assessment and interventions for presented case scenarios.
- 2) Entering and maintaining the OnQ content for the course
