Overview

The ICACBR has been working in the Balkans since 1993. The two phases of the Isabel and Alfred Bader Children's Project began in 1996 and 2008. Each phase lasted for 2 years. The goals of the Isabel and Alfred Bader project included:

- The creation of education programs for children with disabilities.
- The integration of children with disabilities into the public school system.
- Provision of support for local community organizations that aid people with disabilities. This included working to educate and improve the skills of disability related service providers.
- The implementation of training and education initiatives for parents with disabilities. These initiatives were designed to cover topics such as disability awareness, human rights, and business development.
- Strengthening of leadership and advocacy skills for people with disabilities themselves.
